- ☐ 1-3 lightweight travel dresses
- ☐ 7 pairs quick-dry underwear
- ☐ 1 regular bra + 1 sports bra
- ☐ Nipples / nipple covers
- ☐ 4-5 pairs hiking or merino socks
- ☐ SexyModest set / plane outfit + PJs
- ☐ Sun hat / cap
- ☐ Swimsuit
- ☐ Hiking / trail shoes - wear on plane
